



To get the most from your nuisance call blocker phone and for all the features to work, you'll need to subscribe to a Caller Display service from your network provider. Charges may apply.

Making and receiving calls 🕓 🕃

Make and end a call

Press green &, enter phone number using keypad. Press red 😭 to end the call.

Answer a call

Lift handset from base or charger. If the handset is not on the base or charger, you'll need to press green 🕓

Mute

Press during a call. Press to return to your caller.

View or dial a number in Calls list[†]

The Calls list stores details of the last 20 incoming calls.

- **1** Press **a** to open the calls list and scroll to an entry.
- 2 Press green 🕓 to dial the number. Or to view call details, press . DETAILS is displayed. Press

Block incoming call number in your Calls list[†]

- 1 Press , scroll to the entry and press . DETAILS is displayed.
- 2 Scroll to ADD TO BLIST (blacklist) and press
- **3** Enter name using keypad, press *menu*. The number is displayed, press *menu* to save.
- 4 Press red 🛜. Press (Menu), scroll to CALL BLOCKER, press (Menu).
- **5** Scroll to **SETTINGS**, press
- 6 Scroll to **BLOCK MODE** and press elect **BLOCK BLIST**, press elect **BLOCK BLIST**, press elect block b ALWAYS ON, press Always Con is displayed.

To view, delete or add numbers manually to the blacklist go to CALL BLOCKER menu. Note, the same phone number can't be saved in the blacklist and phonebook.

Phonebook

Store entry in phonebook (up to 50)


- 1 In idle mode, press . EMPTY is displayed if there are no numbers.
- 2 Press (Menu) to select ADD. Enter name using keypad and press (Menu).
- **3** Enter phone number and press to save.
- 4 Press Red to select ring melody, then to save.

To save a number to your phonebook from the Calls list, press 🙆. Scroll to the entry you want to save and press (Meru). Scroll to **ADD TO PB** (phonebook) and press (Meru). Enter name using keypad and press (Meru). The number is displayed, press (Meru) to save. Then follow step 4 above.


If you have more than one handset registered to the base, your contacts are automatically updated to all handsets (up to 6 handsets).

Dial entry in phonebook

1 In idle mode, press 🕮.



Handset buttons and display icons



Answer machine

Your answer machine is on and ready to record messages. You can control it using the buttons on the base (see above) or using the handset ANS. MACHINE menu.

Record your own outgoing message

Blue light is on and flashes when phone rings or the handset is in use.

- 1 Press Menu ANS. MACHINE is displayed, press
- 2 Scroll to TAM SETTINGS, press end to OGM SETTINGS, press
- 3 Scroll to ANS & REC and press
- 4 Scroll to **RECORD MESS** and press **Menu** to start recording. **RECORDING** is displayed. Press to stop and save your outgoing message.

Set the answer delay

For compatibility with BT1571 or another voicemail service make sure the answer delay is set to answer before the service, e.g. for BT1571 do not set to more than 5 rings.

- 1 Press Menu. ANS. MACHINE is displayed, press
- 2 Scroll to TAM SETTINGS, press . Then scroll to ANSWER DELAY, press .
- 3 Scroll to select 2 RINGS, 4 RINGS, 6 RINGS or 8 RINGS. Press to confirm.

Press M_{enu} or M_{enu} to scroll through the sub-menus and press to select. • Use to select options displayed above the button, on the display. • Use to exit a menu or go back. • If no buttons are pressed for 30 seconds the handset will return to the idle screen.

Handset volume and sounds

During a call, press a or red to increase or decrease the volume of your caller's voice.

1 Press , scroll region to HS SETTINGS, press .

2 Scroll 📷 to RING SETUP, press 🚰. EXT. RING is displayed.

3 Scroll Redial to RING VOLUME, press

4 Press or Regiant to adjust the volume, press to save.

Press and hold **X** to turn ringer off and on.
